





THE APPROPRIATION ACT, 2002.

An Act to apply a sum of two thousand six hundred and eighty two billion, six hundred and eleven million, four hundred and thirty one thousand shillings out of the Consolidated Fund to the service of the year ending on the 30th June, 2003 and to appropriate the supplies granted.

DATE OF ASSENT: 10th September, 2002.

Date of Commencement: 1st July, 2002.

BE IT ENACTED by Parliament as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 2002 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of July, 2002.

Short title.

2. The Treasury may issue out of the Consolidated Fund and apply towards the supply granted to the Government for the service of the year ending on the 30th June, 2003, the sum of two thousand six hundred and eighty two billion, six hundred and eleven million, four hundred and thirty one thousand shillings.

Appropriation.

3. The sums granted by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes in the amounts specified in columns 1 and 2 of the Schedule to this Act.

Extension of duration of appropriation.

4. Any part of the sums granted by section 2 of this Act which has been, or is issued from the Consolidated Fund on or before the 30th day of June, 2003 shall be available until a date determined by the Secretary to the Treasury (not being later than the 31st day of October, 2003) for making payments which become due during the year ending on the 30th day of June, 2003 to an accounting officer or a receiver of revenue or to an officer administering a fund established under section 17 of the Public Finance Act.
