NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the Electoral Commission subject to Section 16(1)(b) of the Presidential Elections Act No. 16 of 2005, Section 18(1)(b) of the Parliamentary Elections Act, No. 17 of 2005, and Section 172 of the Local Governments Act (Cap. 240) that the area specified in the Schedule to this Notice is hereby designated the tallying venue for purposes of the Local Government General Elections, 2006.

The tallying of votes shall commence as soon as practicable on receipt of the Declaration of Results Forms from the respective polling stations.
